Full-time attendance as an undergraduate at an institution of higher education accredited by the U.S. Dept. of Education is required. Children of private golf club members are not eligible for scholarships.

- 2. Have your parents (or guardian) complete the last section and attached a signed copy of pages 1 & 2 of their 2015 or 2016 Federal Income Tax Return.
- 3. If you are a high school senior, submit a copy of your high school transcript, including you cumulative Grade Point Average, and College Board SAT (or ACT) scores.
- 4. If you are currently enrolled in college, submit a copy of your college transcript, including the 2016 Fall Semester.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The NJSGA Scholarship Committee reviews applications using the following criteria:

-College Board SAT (or ACT) scores

-Financial need

-Qualities of character and leadership

-Golf Club's financial support of the program
