- Please submit a letter of recommendation from a guidance counselor, teacher, scout leader, worship leader, organization leader or employer. Please see attached instructions.

#### Essay Criteria:

Essay is to be two (2) pages, "double spaced" with 1 inch margins. (500-525 words) one copy of the essay must be submitted with the essay application and one copy of the essay is to be sent electronically to OCA.nimembership@gmail.com

- > Academics 10%;
- **Recommendation 10%**;
- Community Service/Civic Engagement 10%;
- Leadership 10%;

- > Application must be legible.
